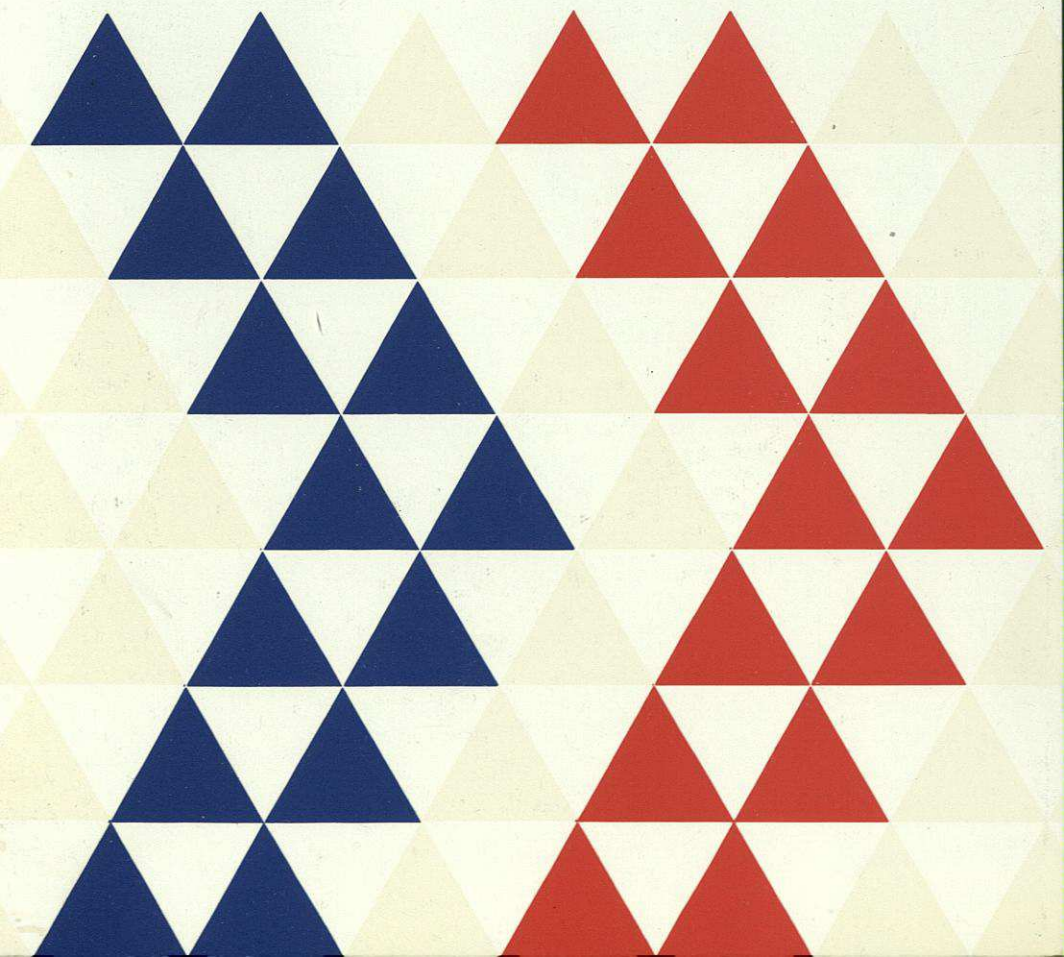

Cannes

Located in the south of France, in beautiful countryside and with an exceptional climate, Cannes is an ideal setting for an international conference. There are many places of interest, gourmet food, and plenty of sporting facilities. We strongly recommend that Foundation members take this opportunity to sample the delights that Cannes has to offer.



Before the Conference

Sunday 15 October

For those arriving on Sunday, we have arranged an afternoon boat trip to the Iles de Lérins, one of which is the site of a monastery.

This will be followed in the evening by dinner in L'Orangerie, with views from the terrace across La Croisette.

Monday 16 October

We have arranged a half-day guided tour to Cap d'Antibes, where the Picasso museum is located, stopping en route for lunch, before visiting the glass factory at Biot.

We shall then return you to the Hotel Martinez, where you will have the afternoon to visit the vast selection of shops, and perhaps enjoy a break at one of the waterfront cafés, or take a stroll in the Forville marketplace.



The Conference

Monday 16 October

The conference will open with a buffet in the Salon Croisette at the Hotel Martinez, decorated in Art Deco style. All delegates and their companions are cordially invited to attend.

The Gala Dinner will be held in the luxury Palm Beach Casino, one of the three casinos in Cannes. You may even be tempted to play a little roulette or blackjack after dinner.

There is plenty to do and see in Cannes. At the Hotel Martinez itself, there are tennis courts, a private beach, and a heated pool. Nearby, you can play golf, try your hand at water sports, or view the countryside on horseback.

For those who prefer more leisurely pursuits, there are many interesting walks – for example, the Suquet (the Roman area), or the Old Port, where there are glass-bottomed boats, as well as the galleon used by Roman Polanski in his film 'Pirates'.

Dinner on Wednesday evening will be typical of the region. Those delegates who are taking part in the industry tour will have the opportunity to meet one another.

Depending on the number of delegates remaining, dinner on Thursday will be either at a local Cannes restaurant or in one of the excellent restaurants within the Hotel Martinez.

On the mornings of Monday 16 and Wednesday 18 October, we are able to offer, as an alternative, a special visit to the Roger Vergé School of Cookery. This comprises a two-hour cookery class under the direction of a Moulin de Mougins chef, followed by lunch. There are limited places available, and the cost will be an additional FF1000 per person.

Tuesday 17 October

A full-day guided tour to Monaco, the residence of Prince Rainier and the Grimaldi family, where we shall visit the old city and see the changing of the guard. Lunch will be at the Café de Paris, in front of the Casino, which you will have the opportunity to visit. We shall continue on to Eze, a small town set in the cliffs overlooking the sea, with its own exotic gardens.

Wednesday 18 October

A morning trip to St Paul de Vence, the home of many artists, and on to Nice for lunch, near the flower market. After lunch, you will have the opportunity to explore Nice, and perhaps visit either the Chagall or the Matisse museum.

For the companions of delegates on the Advanced Technology Tour, we shall be happy to advise on local places of interest.

Accommodation Packages

In addition to the Conference Package, we have arranged three other packages: the Pre-Conference Package for delegates arriving before the conference, and a choice of the Industry Tour Package or the Post, Conference Package for those staying after the conference. The delegate and companion prices of the packages are shown on the enclosed registration form.

The Companions' Package is based on shared occupancy of a twin-bedded room.

Accommodation charges include breakfast, but hotel extras should be settled by delegates on departure.
